

Broadwell Parish Council

The following Guidelines have been written in relation to Location filming within the Parish:

- a) No roads or footpaths should be closed to residents or tourists for the purpose of the filming unless prior permission has been sought from the County Council, and appropriate notice has been given.
- b) Vehicles relating to filming should not obstruct private driveways or block roads.
- c) Cooperation of residents should be on a voluntary basis and at the total discretion of the residents concerned.
- d) Filming activities should not disrupt resident, work or visitor activity in the village.
- e) No filming of private residence is allowed without the prior permission of the owner and/or occupier.
- f) The Company responsible should be adequately covered by Public Liability Insurance. A copy of the insurance certificate should be available for inspection if required.
- g) The Company should notify the Police and Highways Authority of the filming activities within the parish.
- h) If appropriate, the company involved could consider a goodwill donation to compensate residents for the disruption and inconvenience caused by the filming.
- i) The Parish Council would receive such a donation on behalf of residents and the disbursement of the donation would be the responsibility of the Parish Council.
- j) If required, site meetings should be held between the parties involved to ensure there are no misunderstandings on any aspects of the project.
